

Heads-Up!!!

The Knights of Columbus are sponsoring a **School Supplies Drive** for the students of **Tucker Elementary School** in Perry **from July 1st through July 31st**. This school, of about 500 students, qualifies for Title I status (low income). Last year, St. Patrick parishioners donated 10 tubs of supplies and an \$1,100 check!

Hard copy shopping lists of the items they need are in the Narthex (on the table under the tv). It would be a blessing if you would shop for items (listed below) then bring them to Church and put them in the labeled bins in the Narthex.



If you don't have time to shop, you can still help by writing a check to the "Knights of Columbus" and putting "FBO Tucker Elementary School"

in the memo line. Put the check in the Office Box that sits outside the Church Office door. The Knights will make sure the school gets the money.

They really need:

School supplies — (especially) see-through book bags that are at least 9" x 14" (to hold laptop computers), college ruled paper, glue sticks, ball point pens, Mead composition books, sharpened pencils, pencil boxes, tissues, markers (especially flair pens in all colors for teachers), post-it notes of all sizes, and dry erase markers

Personal products — travel size deodorant, toothpaste, tooth brushes, dental floss, girls' hair clips, and ponytail holders

Miscellaneous — ear buds, Astrobrights copy paper, Astrobrights cardstock, white cardstock, copy paper, hand sanitizer, baby wipes, hand wipes, playdough, and paper towels

Clothing — (for girls) socks, underwear, gym or stretch shorts, and leggings (for boys) socks, underwear, stretch or gym shorts, and gym or stretch pants

Sacramental Policies

Baptism

- * Parents **must be registered** at St. Patrick and attend Mass for **3 months before** preparation.
- * Parents must attend Baptism Prep Class so, please **call the office to register for class!**
- * Godparents are invited to attend Baptism class.
- * At least one godparent must be a Catholic good standing.
- * **Non – St. Patrick godparents** must provide a sponsorship letter from their home parish office. The letter must be received by St. Patrick Church office **prior to** requesting a date for the Baptism.

Marriage – Couples must:

- * Contact the pastor **at least 6 months** (or more) **prior** to desired wedding date.
- * Complete FOCCUS inventory
- * Participate in a pre-Cana course or marriage-prep weekend.
- * **NO** wedding date is guaranteed until **ALL** Diocesan and parish requirements are fulfilled.

First Communion and Confirmation

- * Family must be registered at St. Patrick.
- * Preparation = two years of classes.
- * Children must be at least **7 years old** to receive First Communion, **and** at least **14 years old** to receive Confirmation.

The Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People is a comprehensive set of procedures established in June 2002 by the USCCB for addressing allegations of sexual abuse of minors by Catholic clergy.

The Charter also includes guidelines for reconciliation, healing, accountability, and prevention of future acts of abuse.


