

Second Sunday of Easter Sunday of Divine Mercy — April 7, 2024 Gospel Reading: John 20:19—31



St. Maria Faustina Kowalska (born in Poland on August 25, 1905) joined the Congregation of the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy in 1925. Over the course of several years she had visions of Jesus, whereby she was directed to create an image and to share with the world revelations of Jesus' love and mercy.

With the help of her spiritual director, Fr. Sopocko, she found a painter to fulfill the request Jesus had made to her in one of the visions — to "paint an image according to the pattern you see, with the signature: Jesus, I trust in You" — In 1934 the painter Eugene Kazimierowski created the original Divine Mercy painting under St. Faustina's direction.

Sister Maria Faustina died of tuberculosis in Krakow, Poland on October 5, 1938 at the age of 33. Pope John Paul II beatified her in 1993, and canonized her seven years later.



#### St. Patrick Catholic Church Sacramental Policies

## **Baptism**

- \* Parents <u>must be registered</u> at St. Patrick and attend Mass for **3 months** <u>before</u> preparation.
- \* Parents must attend Baptism Prep Class so, please call the office to register for class!
- \* Godparents invited to attend Baptism class.
- \* At least <u>one</u> godparent must be a Catholic good standing.
- \* Non St. Patrick godparents must provide a sponsorship letter from their home parish office. The letter must be received by St. Patrick Church office prior to requesting a date for the Baptism.

#### Marriage - Couples must:

- \* Contact the pastor <u>at least</u> **6 months** (or more) <u>prior</u> to desired wedding date.
- Complete FOCCUS inventory
- \* Participate in a pre-Cana course or marriage-prep weekend.
- \* **NO** wedding date is guaranteed until **ALL** Diocesan and parish requirements are fulfilled.

#### **First Communion and Confirmation**

- \* Family must be registered at St. Patrick.
- \* Preparation = two years of classes.
- Children must be at least 7 years old to receive First Communion, <u>and</u> at least 14 years old to receive Confirmation.

The Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People is a comprehensive set of procedures established in June 2002 by the USCCB for addressing allegations of sexual abuse of minors by Catholic clergy.

The Charter also includes guidelines for reconciliation, healing, accountability, and prevention of future acts of abuse.
