Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

Sunday — June 16, 2024 Gospel Reading: Matthew 4:26-34

Jesus said to the crowds: "This is how it is with the kingdom of God; it is as if a man were to scatter seed on the land and would sleep and rise night and day and through it all the seed would sprout and grow, he knows not how. Of its own accord the land yields fruit, first the blade, then the ear, then the full grain in the ear. And when the grain is ripe, he wields the sickle at once, for the harvest has come."

He said, "To what shall we compare the kingdom of God, Or what parable can we use for it? It is like a mustard seed that, when it is sown in the ground, is the smallest of all the seeds on the earth. But once it is sown, it springs up and becomes the largest of plants and puts forth large branches, so that the birds of the sky can dwell in its shade." With many such parables he spoke the word to them as they were able to understand it. Without parables he did not speak to them, but to his own disciples he explained everything in private.

St. Patrick Catholic Church **Sacramental Policies**

Baptism

- Parents must be registered at St. Patrick and attend Mass for 3 months before preparation.
- Parents must attend Baptism Prep Class so, please **call the office** to register for class!
- Godparents invited to attend Baptism class.
- At least one godparent must be a Catholic good standing.
- Non St. Patrick godparents must provide a sponsorship letter from their home parish office. The letter must be received by St. Patrick Church office **prior to** requesting a date for the Baptism.

Marriage - Couples must:

- Contact the pastor at least 6 months (or more) prior to desired wedding date.
- Complete FOCCUS inventory
- Participate in a pre-Cana course or marriage-prep weekend.
- **NO** wedding date is guaranteed until **ALL** Diocesan and parish requirements are fulfilled.

First Communion and Confirmation

- Family must be registered at St. Patrick.
- Preparation = two years of classes.
- Children must be at least **7 years old** to receive First Communion, and at least 14 years old to receive Confirmation.

The Charter for the Protection of Children **and Young People** is a comprehensive set of procedures established in June 2002 by the USCCB for addressing allegations of sexual abuse of minors by Catholic clergy.

The Charter also includes guidelines for reconciliation, healing, accountability, and prevention of future acts of abuse.


