

### Twenty-third Sunday in Ordinary Time Sunday — September 8, 2024

Gospel Reading: Mark 7:31—37

Again Jesus left the district of Tyre and went by way of Sidon to the Sea of Galilee, into the district of the Decapolis. And people brought to him a deaf man who had a speech Impediment and begged him to lay his hand on him. He took him off by himself away from the crowd. He put his finger into the man's ears and, spitting, touched his tongue; then he looked up to heaven and groaned, and said to him, "Ephphatha!"— that is, "Be opened!"— and immediately the man's ears were opened, his speech impediment was removed, and he spoke plainly. He ordered them not to tell anyone. But the more he ordered them not to, the more they proclaimed it. They were exceedingly astonished and they said, "He has done all things well. He makes the deaf hear and the mute speak."

#### St. Patrick Catholic Church **Sacramental Policies**

#### **Baptism**

- Parents must be registered at St. Patrick and attend Mass for 3 months before preparation.
- Parents must attend Baptism Prep Class so, please **call the office** to register for class!
- Godparents invited to attend Baptism class.
- At least one godparent must be a Catholic good standing.
- Non St. Patrick godparents must provide a sponsorship letter from their home parish office. The letter must be received by St. Patrick Church office **prior to** requesting a date for the Baptism.

#### Marriage - Couples must:

- Contact the pastor at least 6 months (or more) prior to desired wedding date.
- Complete FOCCUS inventory
- Participate in a pre-Cana course or marriage-prep weekend.
- **NO** wedding date is guaranteed until **ALL** Diocesan and parish requirements are fulfilled.

#### **First Communion and Confirmation**

- Family must be registered at St. Patrick.
- Preparation = two years of classes.
- Children must be at least **7 years old** to receive First Communion, and at least 14 years old to receive Confirmation.

The Charter for the Protection of Children **and Young People** is a comprehensive set of procedures established in June 2002 by the USCCB for addressing allegations of sexual abuse of minors by Catholic clergy.

The Charter also includes guidelines for reconciliation, healing, accountability, and prevention of future acts of abuse.




